ECOMAPPING

Eco-mapping addresses the 'Resources' portion of the family assessment, but is not a complete family assessment. An eco-map is a picture of the family's perceived informal, formal, and intermediate supports. An eco-map should be completed in combination with a Routines Based Interview (RBI) to best understand the family ecology.
