Request for Bids: Analysis of Statewide B6 Indicator Data

Background and Statement of Purpose

Established in 2001, the Clinton County Regional Educational Service Agency (CCRESA) Office of Innovative Projects (OIP) partners with state agencies, educational organizations, and local communities to strengthen Michigan's systems of early intervention, early childhood, and special education. Through statewide initiatives, CCRESA OIP advances evidence-informed practices by providing professional learning, faculty supports, online data systems, public awareness campaigns, resource dissemination, and administrative leadership. These efforts help ensure that Michigan's children, families, and professionals have timely access to high-quality services and supports.

On behalf of MiLEAP Office of Early Learning Family Services, CCRESA OIP is seeking bids to analyze IDEA child find data for children ages 3-5 and Part B SPP Indicator 6 data for preschool environments. The B6 data indicates the percentage of children age 3, 4, and 5 with IEPs who are enrolled in a preschool program attending a:

- A. regular early childhood program and receiving the majority of special education and related services in the regular early childhood program,
- B. separate special education class, separate school, or residential facility,
- C. receiving speciation education and related services in the home.

The selected bidder will collaborate with MiLEAP project leadership, the State 619 Coordinator, and the Office of Innovative Projects Training and TA team to analyze B6 data from SY 2020–21 through SY 2024–25.

Deliverable

A report must be produced by October 22, 2026, that includes:

- A. Examination of B6 and child find data at the State level, drilled down to the ISD and LEA levels.
- B. Disaggregation of trends by age and setting to highlight age-group variations.
- C. Identification of areas of measured improvement across the state.

- D. Cross-reference of results with dates of statewide and targeted improvement initiatives and ISD participation and correlating the data.

Format of Response

Interested contractors should submit a proposal that includes:

- 1. Cover Letter**
- 2. Technical proposal** (not to exceed 5 pages), including:
 - a. Understanding of the project and its goals
 - b. Proposed approach to produce the deliverables
 - c. Proposed timeline for completing deliverables
- 3. Contractor qualifications:**
 - a. Resume(s) or brief bios of key personnel(s)
 - b. Previous experience providing data analysis of similar scope
 - c. Previous experience working with early childhood, healthcare, education, and/or community-based resources
- 4. Detailed cost proposal that includes:**
 - a. Applicants shall submit a detailed one-year cost proposal based on an anticipated budget of \$9,800.
 - b. Description of proposed fees and expenses.
